



Round #1 @ Two Eagles GC | Sat, Oct 5, 2024

FORMAT:

- Two – Player Team Event (Round #1: Front 9 - Best Ball, Back 9 - Scotch Ball)
- Tees: Men will play from the **BLACK TEES**. Women will play from the **RED TEES**.
- Team Handicap: Based on lower index of the two-player team converted to the BLACK course handicap for men, RED course handicap for women.
- The field will be split into **THREE FLIGHTS** as determined by team handicap
 - Flight #1: +3-3 HCP (16 teams) | Flight #2: 4-10 HCP (17 teams) | Flight #3: 11-21 HCP (17 teams)
- Gross & Net competition, 36-hole stroke play paid out in MERCHANDISE & GIFT CERTIFICATES
- Optional Daily Cash game (\$50 per team, per day, all gross scoring within your flight)
 - Total purse in each flight will be split four (4) ways;
 - 1st gross score: 25%, 2nd gross score: 15%, 3rd gross score: 10%, Gross Skins Game: 50%
 - Cash purse per flight, per day: **\$650 in Flight #1, \$650 in Flight #2, \$300 in Flight #3**
 - Ties will split any payouts

FORMAT ORDER & SCORING INSTRUCTIONS:

First 9 (#1 to #9) – Best Ball format

- Both players play individual ball
- Please mark the best gross score of the team on card

Second 9 (#10 to #18) – Scotch Ball

- Scotch ball is a scoring format where both players tee off on every hole and order of play is **always alternate shot**. (Player A hits, then player B hits, then player A hits, etc.)
- There are two balls in play to start the hole and one ball in play to finish the hole.
- On par 3's both player A and player B tee off. The team then selects the ball to finish the hole with. If player A's ball is chosen, player B must hit the second shot. Continue with alternate shot until the hole is completed.
- On par 4's, both player A and player B tee off. The player's then crossover for their second shot. The team then selects the ball to finish the hole with. Continue with alternate shot until the hole is completed.
- On par 5's, both player A and player B tee off. The player's then crossover for their second shot and again for their third shot. The team then selects the ball to finish the hole with. Continue with alternate shot until the hole is completed.
- **Penalty shots do not affect order of play. Rule 29-1.**

Closest to the Pin: Hole #4, #9, #12 & #15

LOCAL RULES (Both Courses):

Golf Canada rules will govern all play, except as modified by these local rules.

Artificial Measuring Devices: Artificial measuring devices and GPS units will be ALLOWED during competition. The device MUST NOT breach the rules of golf by giving slope and/or club recommendation.

Out of Bounds: Defined by boundary fences and white stakes. **Please note that Local Rule 18.1 Stroke and Distance is NOT in effect. You must re-hit for all lost or out of bounds balls.**

Obstructions: All staked/flagged trees, flowerbeds, bark mulch beds, yardage markers, irrigation fixtures, and artificially surfaced roads and paths, (including crush gravel paths and extensions from path) are considered immovable obstructions. If your ball is within two club-lengths of an obstruction that is also within two club-lengths of the putting green, you may also take line of play relief. (Rule 16.1b)

Ground Under Repair: All white lined areas are considered ground under repair. Proceed under Rule 16.

Penalty Areas: All penalty areas are defined by red stakes and/or a red painted line.

Round #2 @ Shannon Lake GC | Sun, Oct 6, 2024

FORMAT:

- Two – Player Team Event (Round #2: Front 9 - Scramble, Back 9 - Best Ball)
- Tees: Men will play from the **BLUE TEES**. Women will play from the **RED/WHITE COMBO TEES**.
- Team Handicap: Based on lower index of the two-player team converted to the BLUE course handicap for men, RED/WHITE course handicap for women.

FORMAT ORDER & SCORING INSTRUCTIONS:

Third 9 (#1 to #9) - Scramble format

- Both players tee off
- The team selects the shot they will use and proceeds from that spot
- Continue this process until the hole is completed
- You may lift, clean and place your ball within **one club length** from the spot you select to play from, including bunkers and penalty areas.
- **Minimum of three (3) drives to be used by each player**
- **You cannot move your ball from fringe to the green, or from rough to fairway, or out of a penalty area**

Fourth 9 (#10 to #18) – Best Ball format

- Both players play individual ball
- **Please mark the best gross score of the team on card**

SKILL PRIZES (Individual Prize / All Players):

Closest to the Pin: Hole #2, #4, #14 & #16

Long Putt: Hole #10 & #18

LOCAL RULES (Shannon Lake GC):

Obstructions: Protective netting by clubhouse on hole #9 is considered an immovable obstruction. The cedar hedge behind #10 is considered a protective fence and an extension of the cart path. Free relief is provided under Rule 16 (Immovable Obstruction). The 150-yard markers may be considered moveable obstructions at the player's discretion. If your ball hits the protective netting on hole #3, you must replay your shot with no penalty.

Tunnel: If a ball is hit into the tunnel under Shannon Lake Road while playing #10, you will receive free relief by using the drop area by the #10 green. If the same situation occurs while playing #17, you may use the drop area by the #17 green.

Ground Under Repair: We will be playing "winter rules" in the *general area* for the entire second round at Shannon Lake due to our irrigation project. You may lift, clean and place your ball within **one club length** from the original spot on the best ball format on the back 9.

TIES:

In case of a tie for the overall championship, there will be a sudden death playoff starting on hole TBD. Format order will be scramble, best ball, scramble, best ball, etc. All other ties will be determined by standard Golf Canada retrogression. (best last 18, best last 9, best last 6, best last 3, then hole-by-hole)

DISPUTES: All disputes are to be reported to the rules committee for ruling. If during play, the players cannot agree on a rule interpretation, it is recommended that two balls be played from the point in question, to the completion of the hole, after which a ruling can be obtained from the rules committee, and the proper score recorded.
