

# MEN'S DAY 2025 | TUESDAYS | ALL DAY | 18-HOLES - \$20 ENTRY FEE | 9-HOLES - \$15 ENTRY FEE

The 2025 season will have 15 competitions over 18 weeks of scheduled play. Competition will start on **Tuesday, May 13** and end on **Tuesday, September 9**. There will be no competitions on the days we aerate the greens and/or fairways or on Statutory Holidays (Canada Day).

New for 2025 – Golf Genius. Golf Genius is the industry leader in tournament management software and has been acquired for use in 2025. Golf Genius will host every one of our various leagues and events for 2025.

New for 2025 – Men's Night Majors & Windup. In 2025 we will be trying out 4 Men's Night Majors (May 27, June 24, July 29, August 26). These events will be a shotgun start, with a dinner and formal prize presentation afterwards and will be an exciting addition to our club. The Men's Night windup will return in 2025 to recognize the yearly accomplishments of players both through the points race winners and various analytical achievements provided through golf genius.

**Format:** Blue/White Tees. Players will use **their full Golf Canada handicap** for the competition. If a player is not registered with Golf Canada, he will be assigned a handicap based on one of Golf Genius's solutions.

Flight Breakdown: New for 2025, Flights will be determined based on week-to-week participation numbers. In order to have the most equal balance of prize monies in each flight. Players will be seeded into flights based on their 18-hole handicap. If playing 9 holes, Golf Genius will automatically take the 18-hole handicap and generate a 9-hole handicap for competition purposes.

- #2 (Handicap range based on participants)
- #3 (Handicap range based on participants)
- #4 (Non registered handicap flight)

Eligible Players: ALL Male golfers, 19 years and older!

# Cash SKINS Game: \$5

- Flighted skins game on front 9, gross scoring, paid out in cash
- Make the low score on any hole within your flight and share in the pot

# 50/50 Draw: \$5

- All winnings paid out daily
- Two prize pots awarded, 50% in cash and 50% in a golf shop merchandise prize(s)
- Winners will be posted on-line

#### 9-Hole Option: \$15

#### Gift Certificate SCORING COMPETITION: \$5

- Flighted scoring prizes, net competition on front 9 only, paid out in gift certificates
- We have adjusted the "gift certificate payout grid" based on a prize purse of \$5 per player. This grid is used to determine the amounts and quantity of gift certificates to be issued within each of the three flights

#### Cash SKINS Game: \$5

- Flighted skins game on front 9, gross scoring, paid out in cash
- Make the low score on any hole within your flight and share in the pot

# YEAR-LONG Points Race: Sponsorship TBD - Cash Payout

- Overall net scores each week will win points. Ties will split points.
- Points: 1<sup>st</sup>-500, 2<sup>nd</sup>-450, 3<sup>rd</sup>-400, 4<sup>th</sup>-350, 5<sup>th</sup>-300, 6<sup>th</sup>-250, 7<sup>th</sup>-200, 8<sup>th</sup>-150, 9<sup>th</sup>-100, 10<sup>th</sup> & higher-50
- Potential Top 5 Pay-Out: 1<sup>st</sup>-30%, 2<sup>nd</sup>-25%, 3<sup>rd</sup>-20%, 4<sup>th</sup>-15%, 5<sup>th</sup>-10%
